Coca-Cola Bottlers Japan Inc. has started operations

On April 1, 2017, Coca-Cola West Co., Ltd. (HQ: Fukuoka City, Fukuoka Pref., to be referred to as CCW hereafter) whose commercial area covers the Kinki, Chugoku, Shikoku, and Kyushu regions, and Coca-Cola East Japan Co., Ltd. (HQ: Minato-ku, Tokyo, to be referred to as CCEJ hereafter) whose commercial area covers the Tokyo metropolitan area, South Tohoku, and Tokai regions integrated their businesses to establish Coca-Cola Bottlers Japan Inc. (HQ: Minato-ku, Tokyo, Representative Director & President: Tamio Yoshimatsu, to be referred to as CCBJI hereafter).

CCBJI is the largest Coca-Cola bottler in Asia, covering the sales areas of Tokyo, Osaka, Kyoto, and 35 prefectures and accounting for almost 90% of Coca-Cola sales in Japan. Coca-Cola Bottlers Japan Inc. (CCBJI, Security Code: First Section of TSE 2579), which has been established through the integration between Coca-Cola West and Coca-Cola East Japan on April 1, 2017, is one of the largest soft drink companies in Japan and the largest Coca-Cola bottler in Asia with sales revenue ranked third out of over 250 bottlers worldwide.

We are responsible for manufacturing and selling about 50 brands including "Coca-Cola", "Coca-Cola Zero", "Georgia", "Aquarius", "I LOHAS", "Ayataka", as well as sports drinks, juice, energy drinks, and other carbonated beverages, and deliver high quality and safe products to about 111 million consumers in Tokyo, Osaka, Kyoto, and 35 other prefectures (the South Tohoku, Tokyo metropolitan, Tokai, Kinki, Chugoku, Shikoku, and Kyushu areas).

CCBJI aims for further growth of the Coca-Cola business by combining the experience and know-how which each previous bottler has formed over its long history to create new values and work positively with the community.
