Tokyo, Japan, Feb 3, 2016 - Coca-Cola East Japan Co., Ltd. (Head office: Minato-ku, Tokyo, Representative Dire ctor, President and CEO Calin Dragan) has signed an "Agreement on provision of relief supplies during a disaster" with Gero City, Gifu Prefecture. In line with the agreement, a ceremony was held for the signing of a vending machine installation agreement.



We have fault lines here in Gero City as well, and it is possible that some villages may get isolated in the event of a torrential downpour. This kind of initiative is linked to the safety and security of our residents. Using today's agreement as an opportunity, I hope that collaboration on various activities will continue in future.

We are very grateful that Gero City has given us a platform for this kind of activity. [Outline of vending machine and provision of relief supplies]

This is an original design of Gero City that is used to wrap around the vending machine. This vending machine is installed so that beverages can be supplied free of charge during a disaster, and it will be useful in ensuring a supply of beverages during a disaster. Under the current agreement, each vending machine will provide a relief supply of natural water "I LOHAS 555mIPET."
