Coca-Cola East Japan was established on Jul 1, 2013 through the merger of 4 Coca-Cola bottlers (Coca-Cola Central Japan Company, Mikuni Coca-Cola Bottling Company, Tokyo Coca-Cola Bottling Company, Tone Coca-Cola Bottling Company) in the Kanto and Tokai regions (Tokyo metropolitan area and 12 prefectures).
