
Setting up security cameras, leveraging a part of proceeds from vending machines

■Outline of the agreement

Background

When the city of Noda was considering to install and increase security cameras in order to prevent crime and create a safe and secure city, we proposed this initiative under the "community-based" corporate philosophy to support the creation of a community in which citizens can live safely with peace of mind.

Roles of the 3 parties

Noda City

Act as a security camera manager and select locations to install security cameras.

Noda Police Station

Video of security cameras can be provided from Noda City Hall which acts as a security camera manager.

Coca-Cola Bottlers Japan Inc.

Donate security cameras. Install vending machines, replenish products, manage sales proceeds, maintain and repair the vending machines.

Installation locations (plan)

Vending machines (5 units in total): Noda City Hall, Health Center, "Cyuo no Mori" Central Forest next to Noda Police Station, Noda City Sports Park

Security cameras (3 units in total): School zones etc. in consideration of safety and security of children
